Carl Anthony, visionary architect, urban strategist, and regional equity advocate dedicated his life to the intersection of social, racial and environmental justice. As the co-founder of Urban Habitat, Breakthrough Communities, and former President of the Earth Island Institute, Carl pioneered a new worldview that linked the health of our planet with justice in our cities.

His profound influence reached from the classrooms of Columbia University and UC Berkeley to the halls of the Ford Foundation. He was a mentor to generations of activists, teaching us that to heal the Earth, we must also heal the wounds of our history through growing healthy, just and sustainable metropolitan communities.
